Patients who are not medically stable or suffering from the following conditions (to include, but are not limited too) should be taken to the Main UNMH Emergency Room for Medical Clearance:

1. Medical Exacerbation
2. Overdose
3. Recent Injury
4. ABCDE Conditions
 - i. Alcohol
 - ii. Burns and bruises
 - iii. Confusion
 - iv. Drugs
 - v. Exposure

Uniform Colors

Our employees wear specific colors of scrubs, work shirts, or polos to identify them as both an employee of UNM Hospitals and as a member of the healthcare team identified by the colors they are wearing. The color selections by position are listed below:

- RN Supervisors: Red scrubs
- RN: Black scrubs (includes UBE's, UD's, ED's, Clinical Nurse Specialists, CNO)
- LPN: Khaki scrubs
- UAP: Navy scrubs (includes non-licensed staff in both inpatient and outpatient positions). Navy blue scrubs, polo or work shirt, dependent on position.
- Radiology: Hunter Green scrubs
- Respiratory Therapy: Royal Blue scrubs
- Paramedics (including Rapid Response Team and ED): Pewter scrubs
- OT, PT, SLP: Inpatient Ceil Blue scrubs; Outpatient Medium or Sky Blue polos
- Other Clinical: Wine scrubs (includes other clinically licensed positions)
- Environmental Services: Purpose scrubs
- Nurse Practitioners/Physician Assistants: Aquamarine scrubs
