131,000 nightly\*

- 20 - 25 percent of all homeless
- 4 percent female
- 67 percent served in the last three years
- 1.5 million other veterans are considered at risk of homelessness due to poverty, living conditions and lack of support networks

## VIC Transitional Housing

### Program Eligibility:

- Individual Veteran
- Honorable discharge of any branch of the US Armed Services
- Clean and sober for at least 28 days and will submit to drug screening
- If employable, willing to actively search for employment within the first thirty (30) days of residency

### Services Available:

- Clothing
- Case Management
- Food Baskets (Weekly to Veterans in the Program; Monthly to Low Income Veterans in the Community)
- Daily Living Skills (Budgeting, Job Searches, Grooming, Finding Permanent Housing, Driver's License/Bus Schedules, Referral Services)
- Transportation to VA/Appointments, Shopping and Events
- Assistance with obtaining benefits (VA, Social Security, etc.)

### Program Eligibility:

- Be a Veteran Family
- Served on Active Duty
- Discharged Under Conditions Other than Dishonorable
- Be Homeless or at Risk of Homelessness
- Very-low Income

### Services Available:

- Rapid Re-Housing
- Homeless Prevention
- Temporary Financial Assistance
  - Rental assistance
  - Utility-fee payment assistance
  - Deposits (security or utility)
  - Moving costs
  - Purchase of emergency supplies for a participant
  - Transportation
  - Child care
